Claimants INÊS HENRIQUES and MARÍA DOLORES MARCOS VALERO, by and through counsel, hereby request the Court to stay proceedings on their Claim, filed on November 10, 2017, as Respondent European Athletic Association is in the process of adding the Women's 50km Race Walk Event to the 2018 European Athletics Championships competition program, after which this Claim may be considered moot and Claimants will be in a position to seek dismissal of the Claim by this Court.
